

## ECSC Quorum

Having listed the Pro's and Con's, (see *"Pros & Cons"* & drawing *"Pros & Cons numbers"*) it is my considered opinion that the major concerns of the Quorum are satisfied by this proposition and would recommend that the Committee consider it carefully and move forward with a view to, after dotting a few i's and crossing a few t's, putting it to the membership for their appraisal.

This report completes my remit and whilst I am happy to assist in any negotiations with CHM I will stand back and let the Committee continue.
