
New member joining process 8/10/2022.v4 GS



Following the PN Members visit there should be at least a one to two weeks period of grace while the PNM decides if the club is as he expected, and wishes to proceed with his/her membership application. This period of grace will also allow the club to confirm that the PNM is suitable for the club and will add value to the club rather than just a "user" of the club for personal gain. How often will he/she be using their boat?

The emphasis will be on the PNM to make contact with the club Hon Sec to proceed with the membership. No contact from PNM within 3 weeks from date of visit will be taken as he/she no longer wishes to proceed with the membership application.



After at least one week's grace period, should the PNM wish to proceed to become a member then he/she will return the membership application documents enclosed in his / her information pack fully completed and signed to the Hon sec.

Once verified at the clubs general committee the finance officer will invoice the PNM for membership fees which will include fees for key fob etc. Once the joining fees are paid the PNM will become a member (subject to the one-year probation period which will be monitored).

The new member will be expected to meet the finance officer at the club to receive any key fobs. The hon sec will make a note in the calendar of the new members end of probation date for a review and suitability of his/her full membership of the club at the general committee month prior to end of probation period.
